



HANDGUN RED DOT SIGHT INSTRUCTOR

Course Description (24 hours):

The student will obtain the skill and knowledge to instruct other law enforcement officers in the use of electronic red dot sights as a primary sighting instrument for their duty handgun. Students will obtain the knowledge to develop and implement a red dot sight transition program and an in-service training program for their agency.

- Lunch/Water
- Rain/Cold Weather Gear
- Lap Top Computer * (class material will be provided on a thumb drive)

Students should expect a fast paced and demanding training schedule as we will be presenting a three day lesson plan in two days.

Instructors:

The training staff is comprised of individuals who have a wealth of experience as instructor trainers and have utilized these weapons in real world situations; from police patrol duty and police special weapons teams to military Special Operations conducted in the War on Terrorism.

Dave Kleiber compiled a concurrent 28-year law enforcement and military career; the last 11 of which were with US Army Special Forces. He has an extensive amount of experience as an international marksmanship champion being one of only a handful of Double Distinguished Marksman in the history of the United States Army. Dave has been a law enforcement firearms instructor and instructor trainer since 1999. He has been a multi-jurisdictional SWAT team commander and is a combat veteran having served with US Army Special Forces in Operation Iraqi Freedom I and Operation Iraqi Freedom II. Dave is a Colorado POST Firearms Full Skills Instructor. He has served on the Colorado POST Firearms Subject Matter Expert Committee, has been a lead instructor for the Colorado Law Enforcement Training Academy (CLETA), and currently is a primary instructor trainer for the Colorado POST / County Sheriffs of Colorado firearms instructor certification program. Dave has provided firearms, tactics and leadership instruction to law enforcement and military members across the U.S. and around the world.
