## **LAW ENFORCEMENT DRIVING SKILLS INSTRUCTOR COURSE FAQs**

### **When will training be conducted?**

The fourth day of training may begin around noon depending on the facility used for training. All the other days of training will begin at 0800 hours.

### **What vehicles should be used for training?**

Typically, sedan sized vehicles are used for the pretest and for driving skills final. However, due to the increase of SUV use by agencies these can also be used for this course. We encourage participants to bring the different vehicle platforms to increase the variety vehicle dynamics each new driving instructor will experience during the course.

The only vehicle platform that cannot be used for testing and during portions of this course are full sized trucks. If this is the only patrol vehicle your agency has you can still use it for some of the training, but will be paired with those who brought a sedan or SUV during portions of the course.

Additionally, please ask your supervisors if your agency's vehicles can be operated by members of law enforcement from other agencies during training.

### **What equipment should I bring?**

Only bring the equipment that is normally assigned to your agency's patrol vehicles. Also, please bring either a work issued, or personal laptop computer for the course. During moments when you are not driving we ask that you work on your final presentation (each participant will be required to provide a five-minute presentation during the last day). The association will have a few laptops onsite.

### **What does CLEDSA provide participants for the course?**

A thumb drive with the course lesson plans and support documents will be provided on the first day of the course. Diagrams of the driving exercises utilized during the course will also be provided to better the training experience.
