



## Single Officer Response to an Active Shooter

The Single Officer Response to an Active Shooter program has been developed to provide officers options to either interdict or interrupt an active shooter. After successful completion of this course the student will be well versed in reading and manipulating the environment, understanding and gathering information, and employ effective tactics to save lives in an active shooter incident. The mindset and tactics taught in this course will give the student confidence that they can move to an active shooter quickly and safely and interdict through glass if necessary. This class includes classroom lecture, weapons retention, live range drills to include shooting through glass and force on force practicals. All principals and tactics are supported through force on force training. Required equipment: Simmunition safety gear, weapon and 50 rounds. Duty gear, weapon and 250 rounds practice ammo.
