Utilization of Student Weapon Systems during FX[®] Simunion[®] Scenario Instructor and Safety Certification Course

- 1) The student will be the only person to utilize his/her own converted weapon while training during scenarios. If they give consent for someone else to use their weapon, they do so at their own risk of damage to the weapon.
- 2) The student will present his/her converted weapon to the Simunion[®] Instructor prior to the start of the training day for inspection.
- 3) The Simunion[®] Instructor will maintain control of the converted weapons during scenario training.
- 4) The Simunion[®] Instructor will explain to the student that neither GD-OTS or Simunion[®] is responsible for damage done to the students converted weapon, weapon mounted light, and/or optic system, during the training course.
