Requirements and Restrictions

- **Mandatory Pre-Test:** Students must pass a **POST required skills pre-test** on the first day to attend the remainder of the course.
- **Eligibility:**
 - Must be an **active peace officer** only.
 - Must have a minimum of **18 months experience** in law enforcement.
- **Class Size:** The class is capped at **12 students**.
