Required Equipment

- 10 to 48 speed mountain bike in good mechanical order. The bike must be of sound quality and properly fit the rider.
- The bike **MUST** be equipped with a form of pedal retention approved by IPMBA, a chain stay-mounted side stand and night-riding equipment i.e. headlight that lasts for several hours at 100+ lumen, flashing LED tail-light.
- Each student **MUST** bring and use a properly fitted bicycle helmet and protective eyewear.
- Padded cycling shorts, cycling gloves, a reflective traffic vest, and clothing appropriate for weather conditions are highly recommended.
- A completed Get Active Medical Questionnaire (Will be sent out to students upon registering)

Participant Requirements

- Must already know how to ride a multi-speed mountain bicycle. This course is **NOT** a beginner's bicycle school.
- Should be in good physical condition. For example, students should be able to ride 20 miles at an average speed of 12 mph.
