

# LEADERSHIP in POLICE ORGANIZATIONS<sup>SM</sup>

The International Association of Chiefs of Police (IACP) has recently updated its flagship Leadership in Police Organizations (LPO) training program. Previously a three-week course, it has now been condensed into a more efficient two-week course (one week monthly for two consecutive months) for experienced leaders through command-level personal. LPO models the training concept off dispersed leadership (“every officer a leader”). LPO focuses on leading individuals, groups, and the organization. The course incorporates modern behavioral science concepts and practical leadership strategies to enhance motivation, satisfaction, and performance.
