Sarah is an Investigator for the Colorado Bureau of Investigations. Her detective career includes four years at the Lakewood Police Department working on the Major Crimes and Family Crimes teams. During her tenure, Sarah handled over 1,200 cases including assaults, kidnapping, stalking, domestic violence, sexual assault, shootings, and homicide. Sarah is passionate about developing new detectives and providing them with the resources and skills to be successful investigators.

Kim has been in law enforcement for 12 years and a detective with the Lakewood Police Department for over 8 years as a Crimes Against Children Detective. She investigates sex assaults, sex assaults on children, human trafficking, missing children, child and teen death cases, physical child abuse cases, and the multitude of felony Internet crimes against children. She excels at building chargeable cases by corroborating difficult to prove cases. She has participated and organized numerous Internet Predator Operations as well as human trafficking operations.
